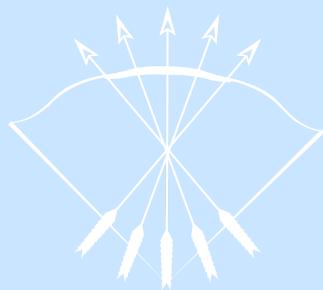

It is with great excitement and deep gratitude that we submit to you the 2019 Annual Report of the Mu Sigma Upsilon Foundation. As an assembly of brave, bold and diverse women, the sisters of Mu Sigma Upsilon and our supporters are passionate about serving others.

Because of the generosity and support of our donors, in 2019 we:

- Awarded \$2,500 in scholarships to assist members with furthering their undergraduate and postgraduate education
- Provided \$730 in Grants to Individuals to attend convention and Undergraduate Chapters for their on-campus programs.
- Donated \$5,600 in MUnited Nations Funds to Individuals for personal emergencies and Organizations for international disaster relief operations.
- Traveled to Puerto Rico with 17 women for our first ever MUnited Nations Missions Trip
- Hosted the 3rd Annual Run Like An Amazon fundraising event
