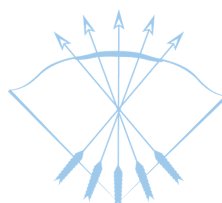

Through the MUnited Nations Program, the Mu Sigma Upsilon Foundation provides financial assistance to support different stages for local and international disaster relief operations.

WHAT IS THE MU MISSION TRIP?

The Mu Sigma Upsilon Foundation Inc. MUnited Nations Missions Trip aims to support an organization each year that dedicates time and funds to a cause that we can align ourselves with. Our first Missions Trip took place in 2019 in Aguadilla, Puerto Rico where 17 of our sisters volunteered over 900 hours to serving the needs of the local communities and we were able to donate \$5,133 towards the purchase of supplies needed on the island of Puerto Rico.

WHY SUPPORT HABITAT'S WOMEN BUILD?

Orlando now has the worst shortage of affordable housing in the nation. Nearly half of families can't consistently cover basic living expenses, and a startling 18% of all households spend more than 50% of their income on housing. They feel like they'll never get ahead.

Habitat offers a hand up by providing a path to affordable home-ownership. For many in our community, affordable home-ownership is the first step toward economic advancement and other benefits associated with home-ownership. Better, affordable living conditions lead to improved health, stronger childhood development and gives families the ability - and financial flexibility - to make forward-looking choices. Homeowners invest financially, physically and emotionally in their homes.

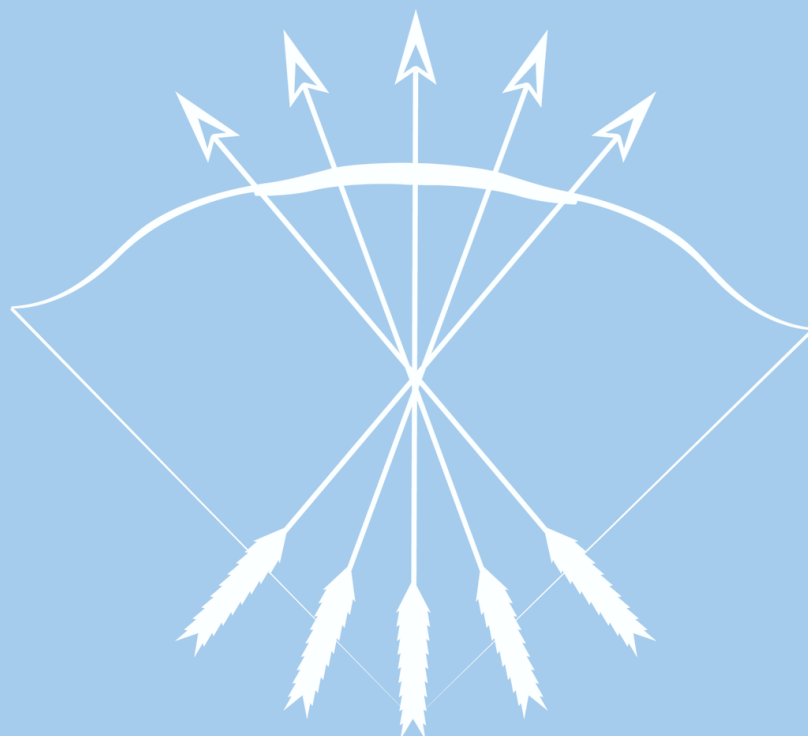
